- Graduated at the University of Bologna in the academic year 1976/1977 with 110 out of 110 with honors, discussing a thesis in Roman Law on the limitations of publicistic character to the urban property, having co-me rapporteur Professor Luzzatto.
- He continued for a couple of years to work as a trainee at the chair of Roman Law at the University of Bologna under the direction of Prof. Enzo Nardi, carrying out teaching activities in the subjects of Institutions of Roman Law, Exegesis of the Sources of Roman Law and Legal Papyrology.
- In 1978 his study on the nature of the legal communion of goods between spouses was published in "Studi in Onore del Prof. Tito Carnacini";
- In the year 1979 he passed the examination of Attorney at Law;
- In the year 1980 he passed the notary competition, obtaining Bologna as the first assigned seat;
- He taught at the School of Notaries of Bologna for five consecutive years (from 1981 to 1986), for three years in the field of succession and for the next two years in the field of company law;
- He was a speaker at the National Congress of Notaries in Naples in 1996, obtaining the publication of a paper entitled "The condition of being a partner" in the Rivista del Notariato 1996 fasc. 4.
- He had an article published in the magazine "Trusts e attività fiduciarie " in November 2009 on the subject of Succession of the trustee (inter vivos) and the tax clause relating to registration tax.
- In 1999/2000 he was President of the Rotary Club Bologna - Valle dell'Idice, obtaining the conferment of the highest Rotary honor, the Paul Harris Fellow;

- In 1999 he was appointed Knight of the Republic.
- He currently works as a notary in Bologna, with offices in Via Dante 6, in association with Notaries Luigi Malaguti and Monica Giacobbe.
